## Quick Wins for JDE Orchestrator

Implementation patterns + effort estimates

JD Edwards Orchestrator eliminates the manual hand-offs that slow your team down. These 10 patterns are the ones GSI deploys most often — each with a clear business case, low configuration overhead, and measurable results. Use this as your starting checklist.

### **01 Reorder Triggers**

Auto-generate POs when inventory falls below defined thresholds — no manual monitoring required.

### **06 Supplier Price Update**

Trigger price book updates when supplier contracts change, synced across all business units.

### **02 Credit Hold Release**

Route credit hold approvals to the right person automatically based on dollar thresholds.

### **07 Work Order Status Alerts**

Notify production supervisors when work orders fall behind schedule or materials are short.

### **03 AP Voucher Routing**

Route supplier invoices through multi-step approval workflows by amount, cost center, or supplier.

### **08 Keep Your Customers Informed**

Proactively communicate order status and information to keep customers in the loop automatically.

### **04 Item Master Sync**

Push item master changes from JDE to WMS, eCommerce, or 3PL the moment a record is updated.

### **09 PO Acknowledgment Tracking**

Flag purchase orders that haven't received supplier acknowledgment within your defined SLA.

### **05 Sales Order Acknowledgment**

Auto-send order confirmations immediately after entry with live item and ship date details.

### **10 Warehouse Transfer Requests**

Let warehouse staff initiate inter-branch transfers from a simple form — Orchestrator handles the rest.
